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Clothing

Just a reminder that we play outside every day unless conditions are hazardous, so please ensure your child always has suitable outdoor clothing (clearly named), especially as weather conditions at this time of year can be very changeable.

Please bring in a pair of named wellies as well as some waterproof trousers so that we can play outside without worrying about getting wet!

Whilst your child is in nursery it is very helpful if can you dress your child in clothing that is easily managed by your child and the staff i.e. no dungarees etc. This is especially important when promoting self-care and independence.

There are lots of sensory and creative activities available for your child at Nursery. Whilst we encourage children to wear an apron, there is always the possibility that your child's clothes may get messy. Dressing for mess means that children can be free to explore without worry.
