


Primrose Hill Nursery Parental Survey (2023/2024)

20 out of 39 completed = 51%


How clear and helpful was the information you received when your child started nursery? 20 responses



Marked on a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being not very clear or helpful and 5 being very clear and helpful.


When your child first started nursery, how happy were you with the way they were welcomed and encouraged to settle in?


Marked on a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being not happy and 5 being very happy.

How approachable are the staff and how well can they answer your concerns? 20 responses




Marked on a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being not approachable and 5 being very approachable.

Marked on a scale of 1 to 5 with 1 being not very confident and 5 being very confident.


How well do you feel you are kept informed of your child's progress and development? 20 responses



Marked on a scale of 1 to 5 with 1 being not well informed and 5 being very well informed.


Have you attended a parent's meeting?


If you have not attended a parent's meeting, why was this?




Have you attended a 'stay and play' session?


