Summer Clothing and Sun Cream

NURSERY FUNDING for SEPTEMBER 2026

If your child receives 30-hour funding, please take a moment to check your HMRC childcare account and make sure your eligibility code is still valid. Parents need to reconfirm their details every three months, and we can only claim the funding if your code is current. If your reconfirmation date is coming up, please complete it promptly so we can apply the hours for the next term. The deadline for applying/reconfirming your code for the Autumn term is 31st August 2026. If you do not reconfirm, you will not be able to claim the funding in September and will have to pay. Thank you.

Please note, you do not have to apply or secure a code for the 15 hours universal entitlement. You are able to access this the term after your child turns 3.
