

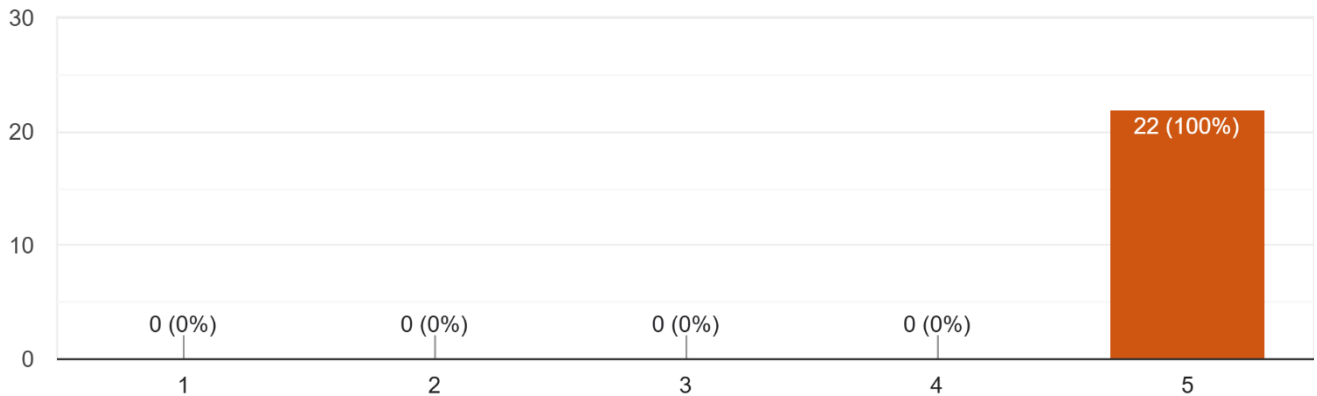


Primrose Hill Nursery Parental Survey (2025/2026)

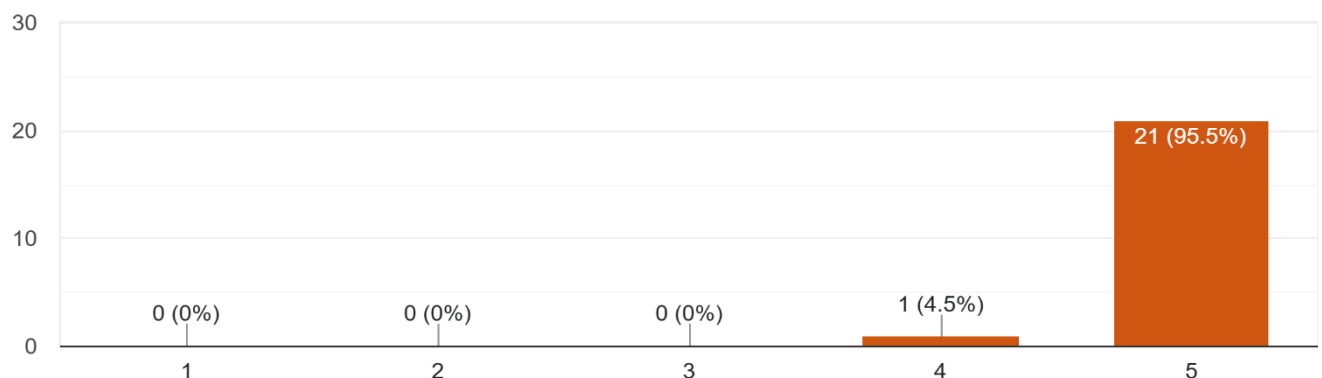
Marked on a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being not very clear or helpful and 5 being very clear and helpful.

How happy have you been with the way your child was welcomed and encouraged to settle in?

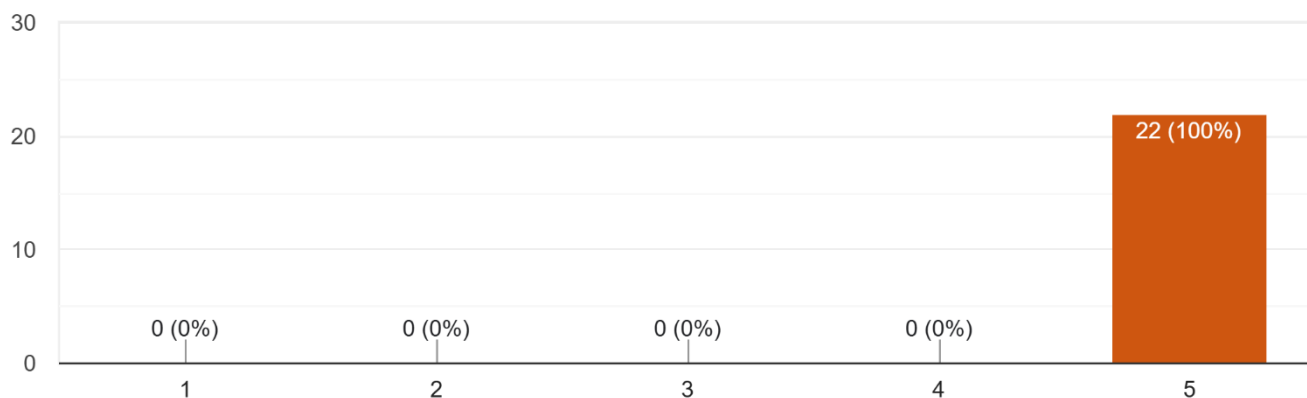

How approachable are the staff and how well can they answer your concerns?

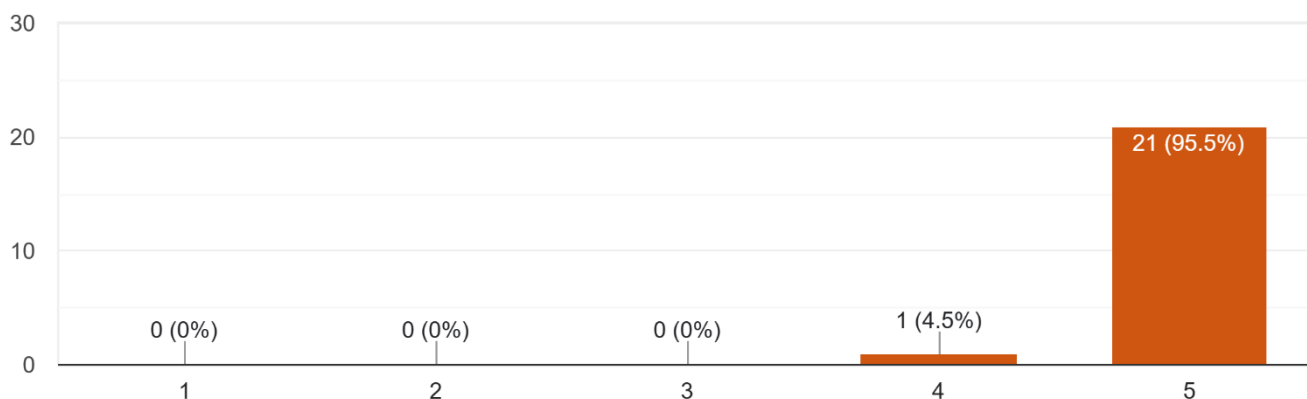

How confident do you feel that your child will be safe and happy at nursery?

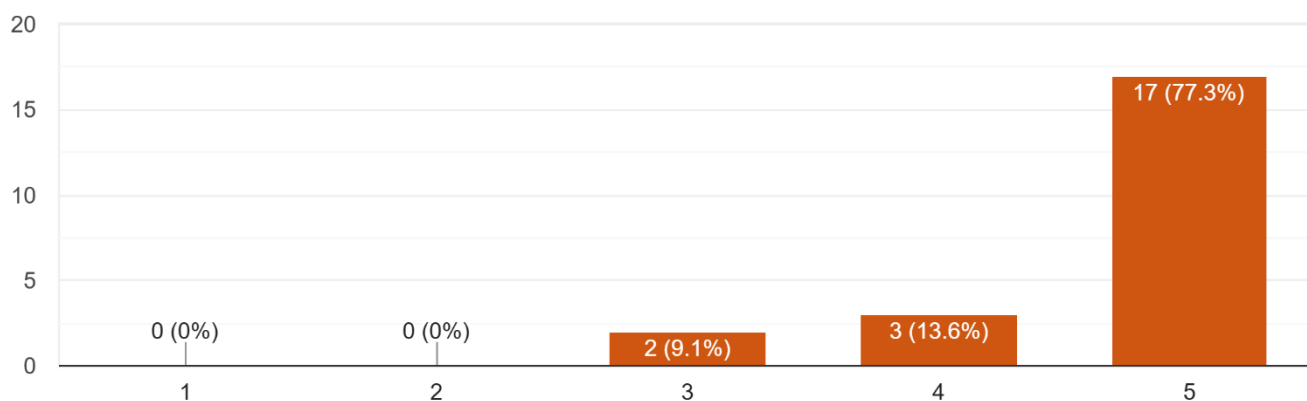

How well do you feel you are kept informed of your child's progress and development?

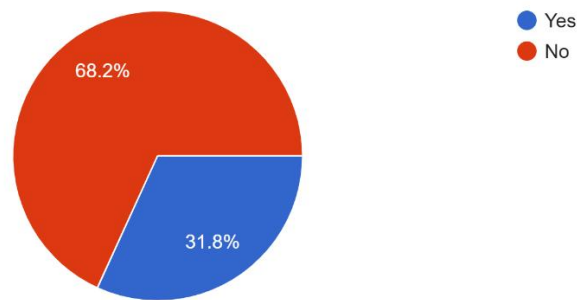

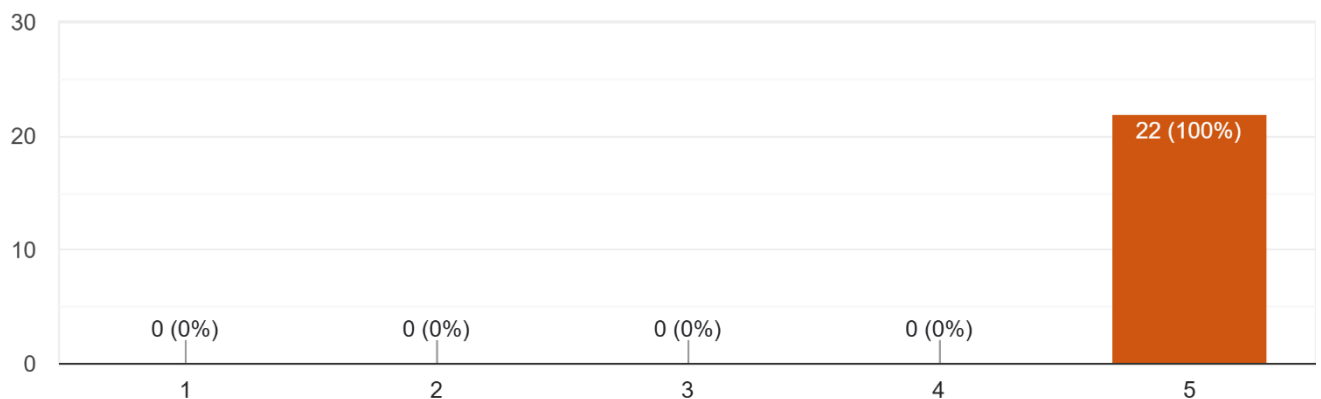


If you did not attend a parent's meeting, why was this? 11 responses
